MATTHEW 25:14-30

INTRODUCTION:

Excellence must be the hallmark of every Christian. As a Christian, you were not just made in the image and likeness of God, but His very life and Spirit is in you. Christians must therefore, cultivate an unquenchable passion for Excellence. Resolve today to pursue excellence and avoid mediocrity and disappointing performances.

The following are required for excellence

1. **Diligence.** This refers to precision and attention to details over a period of time. Diligence is a major difference between mediocre and excellent performance. Diligence will bring the child of God, excellence, promotion and prosperity. Prov.12:24; Prov.10:4; Prov.22:29; 2Peter 3:14
2. **Wisdom.** Wisdom is the principal thing in the pursuit of excellence. Wisdom will confer on you the ability and know how to create superior solutions to life's issues. This wisdom is available in God for every Believer who would desire and ask for it. Proverbs 4:7; James 1:5; Eph.1:17
3. **Faithfulness.** This refers to reliability, trustworthiness, loyalty and thoroughness. To deliver excellent results you must doggedly stay

Child of God, you are destined to shine. Do not exist in silence. Your presence must be felt in this world. Give light to your world because that is what you were called, created and destined for. (Matthew 5:14) *"Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid."* Do not let anything cover your light.

Ordinary, impactless existence is not for you. God told Abraham to be a blessing to all families on earth. (Genesis 12:2) *"... and thou shalt be a blessing."* Ordinary existence is a worse evil than non-existence. Refuse to tolerate, accept and accommodate an ordinary and colourless life. Others might have been stopped and covered from shining by the darkness of occultism, witchcraft and family wickedness, but you shall not be stopped. Make up your mind that whatever cannot cover God cannot cover your light.

Rise up and shine, fulfill your divine purpose and destiny. You are God's answer to the darkness of your family, household and society. God's plan for you is to shine and keep on shining. (Proverbs 4:18) *"The path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day."*

Shine on despite the hatred, jealousy and evil conspiracy of men. Their manipulation cannot stop

you. Men only fear what they cannot stop. They cannot stop you in Jesus name.

But I keep under my body, and bring it into subjection: lest that by any means, when I have preached to others, I myself should be a castaway.

1 Corinthians 9:27

Beloved, there are certain conditions necessary to stay in tune with God. To live consistently and continuously in holiness there are principles you must stick to. In our text today, Apostle Paul tells us how he disciplined his body to maintain a life of holiness. A holy life is not maintained by wishful thinking or arrogantly believing that because you are born again, you cannot fall. Keeping yourself holy will require wise, intelligent and deliberate steps.

Let's look at some steps:

1. **Hunger and thirst after God, His Word and righteousness.** If you must stay holy, you must seek and serve God more than anything else. (Psalms 119:10-11) *"With my whole heart have I sought thee: O let me not wander from thy commandments. Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee."*
2. **Have a repentant spirit.** This is neither guilt nor regret. It is not remorse but rather, Godly sorrow, for Godly sorrow works repentance unto salvation. (2 Corinthians 7:10) *"For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation not to be repented of: but the sorrow of the world worketh death."*
3. **Abhorrence of evil.** To maintain holiness, you

must abhor evil. This means you must abstain from everything that appears evil. Sift every thought, emotion, desire and plan through the counsel of the Word of God and flee from every sin. (Job 1:1. MSG) *"Job was a man who lived in Uz. He was honest inside and out, a man of his word, who was totally devoted to God and hated evil with a passion."*

4. **Have a conscious, deliberate and purposeful attachment to what is good.** Let your actions, association, environment and leisure be spent on things that are good, wholesome and soul lifting. Let your good be seen in your consistent lifestyle of holiness and holy living. (Matthew 5:16) *"Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father..."*

THE SECRET OF SHINING

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.

Matthew 5:16

Shining is possible, all that is required is for you to find out what it takes. There are principles to apply to enjoy a life of shining and glory.

Let's look at some secrets that make shining possible.

- **Your connection to God.** (Psalm 27:1) *"The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?"* Your connection to God affects your shining in life.
- **Your dependence on God.** (Exodus 33:13) *"Now therefore, I pray thee, if I have found grace in thy sight, shew me now thy way, that I may know thee, that I may find grace in thy sight ..."* Dependence on God guarantees radiance in life.
- **Your devotion to God.** (John 1:9) *"That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world."* Spend time with God and you will receive light to shine. The light of Jesus is bright enough to make any man shine and stand out in this world.

Child of God, reject a life of failure, frustration and backwardness. God can light you up to shine in your

world. All the men that did exploits in the bible from Adam, all the way to Apostle Paul, it was the light of God that lit them up. I see you shining in your world.

What does it mean to make a way?

1. **To provide a path or passage to a desired destination.** (Exodus 14:21) *"And Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the Lord caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea dry land, and the waters were divided."* Every destination in life has a pathway and without God showing you the pathway, you will labour in vain.
2. **To create access through a blockade.** (Joshua 6:5) *"And it shall come to pass, that when they make a long blast with the ram's horn, and when ye hear the sound of*

the trumpet, all the people shall shout with a great shout; and the wall of the city shall fall down flat, and the people shall ascend up every man straight before him."

3. **To provide a solution, idea, enlightenment or revelation.** (Genesis 21:19) *"And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water; and she went, and filled the bottle with water, and gave the lad drink."*

Beloved, never conclude that there is no way. Ask God to make a way for you. Ask God today to show you the path to your destination. I see God making a way for you now!

Deborah sat in her office as a judge when required. She also gave enough time to her husband Lapidoth, this enabled her to maintain a conducive home front.

JESUS CHRIST: Jesus strategically recruited His discipleship team, developed them, then sent them

“...to the ends of the earth.” (Acts 1:8). His strategy included public teachings and miracle-working. Ultimately, His strategy took Him, all the way to the cross, the grave and the resurrection. Jesus' coming to earth, suffering, death and resurrection was God's strategic plan for redemption. If God, the creator of the universe, needed a strategy to succeed, who are you to think you can succeed without strategic planning? Stop living life carelessly, develop a strategy for success in life and destiny today.

harvest."

- **The banquet must be published.** (Psalm 68:11) *"The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published it."*
- **No excuses are accepted for rejecting salvation.** (Romans 2:1) *"Therefore thou art inexcusable, o man ..."*

The banquet of God's salvation requires a great company of publishers. Rise up and obey the call to go and preach the gospel.

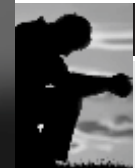

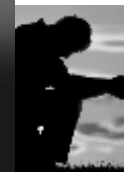
Eyesight and vision affect the success of your whole life. The eagle is such a successful bird because of its quality eyesight and vision.

INTRODUCTION:

The call to soul winning (the Great Commission) is a must for every genuine Christian. It is a sure proof of your Christianity. Soul winning is so important that Jesus made all His followers "fishers of men" i.e. soul winners. One major reason Christians are empowered by the Holy Spirit is for soul winning.

Those who win souls are wise. Some ways to win souls include

1. **Preaching the Gospel.** To be a soul winner you must be a preacher of the gospel. The Gospel is the Power of God unto Salvation. Until the Gospel is preached and understood the lost soul/sinner cannot be saved. Someone shared the gospel to you and you must also share to others. Matt.28:19-20; Mark 16:15, Rom.1:16; Romans 10:13-15
2. **Your Character and Conduct.** Actions they say speak louder than words. To be an effective soul winner, your character and conduct must align with the message of the Gospel. Remember you are an ambassador of Christ and your Character can potentially attract/repel a lost soul to/from Christ. 2 Corinthians 5:20; 1 Timothy 4:12; Matthew 5:16

3. **Demonstrating Love not Condemnation.** Being judgemental of others will not attract them to Christ. To be a soul winner you must demonstrate love like Jesus Christ, who came not to condemn but to save. People will naturally get interested in your message when you care and show love. John 3:17; Rom.5:8; John 13:35; 1John 4:8-10

CONCLUSION

One of these days all your material and earthly acquisitions will not matter anymore. What will count most will be the many souls that encountered Christ through you. Soul winning will lay up for you treasures in heaven where moth will not corrupt. Be a profitable servant and win souls for God's kingdom.

1. **Serve God fervently:** (Romans 12:11) *"Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit serving the Lord."*
2. **Serve God joyfully:** (Psalm 100:2) *"Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing."* The level of profitability you enjoy in kingdom service is determined by the state of your heart investment.
3. **Serve God excellently.** (1 Chronicles 22:5) *"... the house that is to be builded for the LORD must be exceeding magnificent, of fame and of glory throughout all countries ..."*
4. **Serve God humbly.** (Micah 6:8) *"He hath shewed thee, o man, what is good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God."*

5. **Serve God expectantly.** (Colossians 3:24) *"Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ."*

Beloved, serve God confidently because He is a faithful rewarder of every diligent service rendered to Him.

CAST YOUR CARES ON GOD

LUKE 12:25-32

INTRODUCTION:

To "Cast" in the context of our text means to throw something on another with the idea of leaving it there and not picking it up. "Care" refers to our worries, concerns and pressures of life. Our God is loving and caring and wants you to cast all your care on Him.

To achieve this you must:

1. **Believe That God Loves And Cares About You.** Until you come to the knowledge and understanding of how much God loves and cares for you, you will never be able to trust God to handle your cares. Luke 12:25-31, 1Peter 5:7; Rom.8:32; Matt.10:30
2. **Be Prayerful. Prayer is an opportunity to communicate with God concerning your cares.** The Bible enjoins us to take advantage of Prayer in making our requests known to God. An effective prayer life is a means of casting your care on God. Talk to God about it and He will handle it. Phil.4:6-7; Jer.33:3; James 5:13; Eph.6:18
3. **Have an Untroubled Heart.** It is your responsibility to ensure your heart is not troubled. Don't focus on the storm or the size of your "Care" but on the Love, Strength and

Faithfulness of God. Instead of avoidable worry and trouble engage Prayer and supplication.

CONCLUSION

Beloved, you can actually live life "care-free" not because you are careless and irresponsible but because God cares and loves you. God's salvation plan has provision for your total wellbeing. Stop that worry and anxiety and cast all your cares on Him.

(Malachi 3:6) *“For I am the Lord, I change not; therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed.”*

Note the following:

- 1. Believe who God says He is.** When God tells you He is your healer, make up your mind and believe Him. Believe that God is your healer today. Don't just come to God in prayer, come believing in God as your healer. (Hebrews 11:6) *“...for he that cometh to God must believe that he is ...”*
- 2. Believe God is able.** God is a healer, therefore He can heal all diseases and sicknesses. (Matthew 9:28-30) *“...Believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, Yea, Lord. Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. And their eyes were opened...”*

- 3. Believe God is willing.** (Mark 1:41) *“And Jesus, moved with compassion, put forth his hand, and touched him, and saith unto him, I will; be thou clean.”*

There be three things which are too wonderful for me, yea, four which I know not: The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid.

Proverbs 30:18-19

The flight of the eagle is a glorious wonder to behold. Most of the time the eagle begins its flight from the nest, high up on the tree top or from the cleft of the rock. Having its nest high up in the treetop helps its flight. At other times it begins its flight from the ground after catching its prey.

Note the following about the eagle:

1. **Eagles grow and develop large strong wings that make flying and soaring possible and graceful.** The wingspan of an adult eagle covers about 6-7 feet. The wings are large enough to carry its body weight and that of prey three times its weight. (Ezekiel 17:3, 7) "...A great eagle with great wings, longwinged, full of feathers ... there was also another great eagle with great wings and many feathers." Grow and develop your mind, spirit, potentials, gifts, talents and skills. Development enhances accomplishments.
2. **Capacity for lift and flight.** The wings of the eagle are not just big and large, they carry strong muscles for takeoff and sustained flying. To fly high in life,

you have to eliminate the things that weigh and drag you down. Sin, guilt, doubts, wrong character, ignorance, laziness and anger are weights that limit your capacity to fly. (Hebrews 12:1) "*Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us...*"

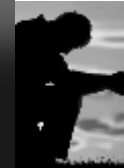
Genesis 1:20

3. Every pronouncement from God's mouth carries power for unstoppable manifestation. God has healed, blessed and increased others by His

May your life become like Isaac's in Jesus name.

If you must enjoy unstoppable enlargement:

1. **You must enlarge your vision.** Any future you cannot see, you will never get. See what God promised those who maintain the right vision: (Genesis 13:15) *"...all the land which thou seest, to thee will I give it..."* Your enlargement stops where your vision stops.
2. **You must secure divine guidance to enjoy unstoppable enlargement:** This is important because God is only committed to what He has commanded. God told Isaac, (Genesis 26:2) *"... go not down to Egypt*

..." To go without God is to go down. It is not about whom you know; but about God going with you to back you up.

Ask God for guidance before you step out.

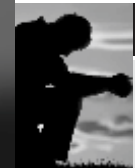

SUNDAY SCHOOL OUTLINE **ACCESSING DIVINE SUPPLY**

GENESIS 26:1-25

INTRODUCTION:

One major benefit of being a Christian is access to divine supply. God has promised to supply all the needs of those who have Him as their Shepherd. Those who have God as their Shepherd and follow His leading and instructions enjoy access to divine supply.

Let's consider some basic facts about divine supply

1. **There's Provision From God for The Believer's Supply.** God has promised to supply the needs of all who see Him. When you place God and His Kingdom first in your life, you trigger an unstoppable supply of all your needs. Ps.23:1; Ps.34:10; Matt.6:33; Rom.8:32
2. **Divine Supply is not determined by the environmental/economic variables of your location.** The Child of God is preserved and supernaturally provided for even in the most adverse conditions. Isaac and Elijah are scriptural examples of supernatural Divine supply. Ps.33:18-19; Gen.26:12-13; 1Kings 17:5-6, 15-16; Ps.37:18-19
3. There are conditions to accessing divine supply. This includes

- putting God and His Kingdom first in all your pursuits including your finances
- Committed and Passionate kingdom service
- Partnering in building Kingdom Projects,
- Sacrificial Sowing and Tithing
- Obedience to God's word and precepts.
Matt6:33; Exo.23:25; Gen.8:22; Ps.84:11

CONCLUSION

Divine supply is one of the infallible promises of God to every Christian who engages the principles of prosperity in the Bible. Jesus came that every Christian might enjoy life in abundance. You are a joint heir with Christ; Rise up and enjoy the best of God.

3. **Stagnation is replaced with progress:** (Genesis 26:12-13) *"...and the Lord blessed him. And the man waxed great, and went forward, and grew until he became very great."*

4. **Sickness and death is replaced with health and life:** (Luke 13:11-13) *"And, behold, there was a woman which had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years and was bowed together... And he laid his hands on her: and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God."*
