

And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplication, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes **Daniel 9.3**

he lifestyle of fasting and prayer is key to a life of impact and exploits. Fasting is a key to divine empowerment. When you fast, ignore the physical weaknesses you feel, and focus on the spiritual benefits you stand to gain.

Why is fasting necessary?

- 1. **Fasting is a supernatural key for accessing more of Gods glory**. Jesus engaged in fasting. "And when he had fasted forty days and forty nights, he was afterward an hungred." (Matthew 17:2)
- 2. **Fasting is a necessary key for victory over stubborn issues.** (Mark 9:29) "And he said unto them, This kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting."

Daniel fasted and enjoyed the following wonders:

- 1. **All-round revival and renewal.** (Daniel 1:15) "And at the end of ten days their countenances appeared fairer and fatter in flesh than all the children which did eat the portion of the king's meat."
- 2. **Impartation and activation of potentials.** (Daniel 1:17) "As for these four children, God gave them

knowledge and skill in all learning and wisdom: and Daniel had understanding in all visions and dreams."

- 3. **Termination of attacks and conspiracies.** (Daniel 6:23) "...Daniel was taken up out of the den, and no manner of hurt was found upon him, because he believed in his God."
- 4. The revelation of mysteries and secrets for solutions and answers. (Daniel 2:47) "...Of a truth it is, that your God is a God of gods, and a Lord of kings, and a revealer of secrets, seeing thou couldest reveal this secret."

Beloved, fasting is highly beneficial to everyone that engages it effectively. Do not ignore the call to fast, both personally and corporately.

- 2. **Healing of all sicknesses.** (Isaiah 53:5) "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed."
- 3. **Deliverance from all limitations.** (Galatians 3:13. AMP) "Christ purchased our freedom [redeeming us] from the curse (doom) of the Law [and its condemnation] by [Himself] becoming a curse for us, for it is written [in the Scriptures], Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree (is crucified)."
- 4. **Supply of all expectations.** (Philippians 4:19. AMP) "And my God will liberally supply (fill to the full) your every

need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus."

5. **Empowerment for record-breaking exploits.** (John 1:12) "But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name."

Surrender your life to Jesus today and experience an unending release of the power of Jesus for miracles, signs and wonders.

The Bible says in 2 Timothy 3:16 that "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable...", The Message Bible translation says, "Every part of Scripture is God-breathed and useful one way or another..."

God rewards those who engage the key of prayer and fasting. (Matthew 6:18)

"...thy Father, which seeth in secret, shall reward thee openly."

Some benefits of fasting include.

- 1. Dominion over the flesh: When you fast, the flesh is subjected and subdued under the spirit. (Deuteronomy 8:3) "And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of the Lord doth man live."
- 2. **Humility that secures God's grace, mercy and promotion.** (James 4:10) "Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and he shall lift you up.".

- 3. **Speedy divine intervention and turn-around.** (Joel 2:21) "Fear not, O land; be glad and rejoice: for the Lord will do great things."
- 4. **Recovery, revival and restoration.** (Joel 2:25) "And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpiller, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you."
- 5. **Spiritual outpouring and empowerment for exploits.** (Joel 2:28) "And it shall come to pass afterward, that I will pour out my spirit upon all flesh; and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, your old men shall dream dreams, your young men shall see visions."

Beloved, when you fast, do it well with the consciousness of the benefits and rewards. (1 Timothy 4:15) "Meditate upon these things; give thyself wholly to them; that thy profiting may appear to all."

SUNDAY SCHOOL OUTLINE BRIDLE YOUR TONGUE

JAMES 3:2-10

INTRODUCTION:

he bible explicitly states that Death and Life are in the power of the tongue. Anything that has control of life and death must be very important and powerful. Indeed the tongue plays an important role in shaping the course of a person's destiny. Therefore the need to bridle your tongue cannot be over emphasised.

Some ways to achieve this include

- 1. **Avoid Corrupt Communication.** Every believer must refrain from corrupt communication. Don't just talk for talking sake but consciously guard the words of your mouth. Avoid the company of loquacious people who either enjoy or engage in corrupt communication. Col.3:8, Eph.4:29a; Eph.5:4;1Tim.6:20
- 2. **Speak Graceful Words That Edify.** As a believer, your words don't only carry power, they also reflect the state of your mind. Resolve to engage only in communication that edifies and ministers grace to the hearers. Let your words be a testimony of your relationship with Christ. Eph.4:29; Col.4:8, Tit.2:8
- 3. **Study And Meditate On The Word Of God.** God's word has the power to influence and

transform the character of your speech and communication. Flood your heart and mind with the word of God, for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. Psalm119:9; Luke 6:45; Matt.12:34; John 15:3

CONCLUSION

Never forget you are royalty. Your words carry power and authority and most importantly they are seeds for your future. Make up your mind today to say only those things that look like the future you desire.

AVOID HYPOCRISY

MATTHEW 23:25-30

INTRODUCTION:

ypocrisy refers to a pretense of having some desirable or publicly approved attitude. Hypocrisy is a plague that should be avoided by every Christian. A hypocrite lives a lie and by extension denies himself the opportunity of seeking God for grace to become that which he desires. Pretenses are unsustainable and would usually bring a shameful end.

Some hypocritical conduct to avoid are

- 1. **Saying With The Mouth But Having A Different Thing In The Heart.** They bless with the mouth but curse inwardly; they say they will but never do. Their words are never in agreement with their acts. Psalm62:4b; Isa.29:13; Matt.15:8; Matt.23:3b
- 2. **Eye Service And Men Pleasing.** Do whatever you do with a heart conviction and not for eye service. God sees the heart and judges the motives. Everything should be done with singleness of heart as unto God. Ephesians 6:6; Col.3:22; Titus 1:16
- 3. **Having a Split Personality.** Don't live a double life. Don't admonish others to do the evil you would not do. Stop living unholy when you are

not in church and yet act holier than thou when in church. Such a life will bring judgement and Condemnation for there is nothing hidden from God. Rom.2:21-22; Matt.7:15, 21; Matt. 23:4-5

CONCLUSION

Make up your mind to avoid hypocrisy. Let your yes be yes and do everything as unto God. Hypocrites will receive nothing from the Lord. Receive grace to avoid hypocrisy in Jesus name. Amen

But Jesus replied to him, Permit it just now; for this is the fitting way for [both of] us to fulfill all righteousness [that is, to perform completely whatever is right]."

Beloved, the Bible admonishes us to live our lives like Jesus. We can please and enjoy great benefits from God by following in the footsteps of Jesus. (1 John 2:6. AMP) "Whoever says he abides in Him ought [as a personal debt] to walk and conduct himself in the same way in which He walked and conducted Himself."

(Isaiah 60:4) "Lift up thine eyes round about, and see: all they gather themselves together, they come to thee: thy sons shall come from far, and thy daughters shall be nursed at thy side."

Only a vision that is worked on and worked at will work out. Visions are received by the interested, focused and expectant. Where you have interest is where you will receive insight.

It is easy to recognize what you are looking for when you have a vision of it. Vision is needed by everyone, everywhere at every time in every field and on every level.

Some vision languages to note:

- 1. **Conviction:** If you can believe for it, it can become your reality.
- 2. Motivation and stirrings from older minds.
- 3. **Provocation:** One way of pushing forward into relevance is to find one problem and solve it.
- 4. Manifestation: If you can picture it in another

person's life, you can have it. Allow other people's results to spark faith in you. What you admire, you attract.

One of the kinds of vision we must have is divine vision. This talks about what we are to do for the kingdom of God. See yourself in God's kingdom plan and mandate. See divine responsibility, direction and God's divine intervention. (Matthew 6:33-34) "But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself."

Some vision languages to note:

- 1. **Revelation or divine appearances.** (Genesis 31:10-12. MSG) "Once ...I had a dream and saw the billy goats, all of them streaked, speckled, and mottled, mounting their mates. In the dream an angel of God called out to me, 'Jacob!' "I said, 'Yes?' "He said, 'Watch closely..."'
- 2. **Impressions or heart burdens.** (Acts 7:23-24) "And when he was full forty years old, it came into his heart to visit his brethren the children of Israel. And seeing one of them suffer wrong, he defended him..."
- 3. **Illumination or scriptural discoveries.** Study the scripture with the desire to make discoveries. (Daniel

- 9:2) "In the first year of his reign I Daniel understood by books the number of the years, whereof the word of the Lord came to Jeremiah the prophet."
- 4. **Imagination or quickened ideas.** (Genesis 11:6. AMP) "And the Lord said, Behold, they are one people and they have all one language; and this is only the beginning of what they will do, and now nothing they have imagined they can do will be impossible for them."

Another kind of vision you must have is personal vision. Have a vision for yourself and advancement. See possibilities, opportunities and potential for creativity.

- 3. **Perception or pull of discernment.** There are some things you will not see by revelation, but by perception.

(John 4:19) "The woman saith unto him, Sir, I perceive that thou art a prophet."

4. **Intentions or exercise of will.** (Luke 14:28) "For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?"

As children of God, we should develop a territorial vision. A vision for our family, loved ones, friends and ultimately the kingdom of God. See progress, positivity and solutions to the problems found in your family and the kingdom of God.

4. **Be committed to service to God and man.** (Luke 5:3) "And he entered into one of the ships, which was Simon's, and prayed him that he would thrust out a little from the land. And he sat down, and taught the people out of the ship. And when they had this done, they inclosed a great multitude of fishes: and their net brake."

- 2. **The Word Of God Is Forever Settled And Cannot Fail.** It is impossible for Gods word to fail. It prospers in her assignment and accomplishes that which pleases God. Everything in life is a product of the word of God 1kings 8:56; Isa.55:11; John1:1-3; Psalm 119:89
- 3. **The Word Of God Is a Powerful Spiritual Weapon.** The word of God is quick and powerful. The word of God is like fire and like hammer. The word of God is the sword of the

spirit and nothing can resist the power of God's word. Eph. 6:17; Jer. 23:29; Heb. 4:12; Heb. 11:3
