The bible makes reference to an endless period of time called eternity.

Isaiah 45:17 ... world without end

Ephesians 3:18 ... world without end

Exodus 15:18 ... For ever and ever

John 8:35 ... For ever

HEAVEN: GOD'S DWELLING PLACE

In the Bible, the word heaven is used differently at various times to refer to:

1. The skies above

... her judgement reacheth unto heaven and is lifted up even to the skies.

Jeremiah 51:9

Another bible passage confirms this also.

There is none like unto the God of Jeshurun, who rideth upon the heaven ... on the sky

Deuteronomy 33:26

2. The spiritual realm where God dwells and rules. Our God is a spirit and He dwells and rules in heaven.

The heaven is my throne, and the earth is my footstool.

Isaiah 66:1a

Look down from thy holy habitation, from heaven, and bless thy people.

Deuteronomy 26:15a

Hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place: and when thou hearest forgive

1 Kings 8:30b

3. Paradise, a temporary resting place for believers.

The bible tells us of a place of rest for believers called Paradise of God (Revelation 2:7). Paradise is also called heaven in the bible.

I knew a man in Christ ... such an one was caught up to the third heaven ... He was caught up into paradise ...

2 Corinthians 12:2-4

4. The final and eternal dwelling place of believers with God.

This is also the heaven where God dwells, and those who believe in Jesus Christ will be there with God.

For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout ... then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up ... to meet the Lord ... and so shall we ever be with the Lord.


1 Thessalonian 4:16-17

Believers in Christ shall be with the Lord Jesus Christ in heaven eternally. Be sure you are born again. Give your life to Jesus and live to glorify Him. Those who believe in Jesus as their Lord and Saviour will spend eternity with the Lord in heaven.

he human spirit is created eternal. It does not cease to exist even after death. Death is not the end of our existence.

Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.

Ecclesiastes 12:7



THERE IS A RESURRECTION

After death the spirit of man appears before God to await the resurrection of the dead. There shall be a resurrection of the dead.

The resurrection of the dead is revealed throughout the bible. In the Old Testament the bible records:

As for me, I will behold thy face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied when I awake, with thy likeness

Psalm 17:15

In Job 19:25-27 we also read:

For I know that my redeemer liveth and that he shall stand at the later day upon the day: And though after my skin worms destroy this body, yet in my flesh shall I see God: Whom I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold ...

The prophets in the Old Testament also revealed the resurrection of the dead:

Thy dead men shall live, together with my dead body shall they arise. Awake ... ye that dwell in the dust: ... the earth shall cast out the dead.

Isaiah 26:19

And many of them that sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, some to everlasting life, and some to shame and everlasting contempt.

Daniel 12:2

Death is not our end. Every person shall be resurrected. What will be your future after your resurrection? Will you awake – to everlasting life or to everlasting shame and contempt?

The sinner, who died without repenting and receiving salvation through Jesus Christ, will resurrect to everlasting shame, contempt and condemnation in hell.



JESUS TAUGHT ON IT TOO

Jesus Christ taught on the resurrection of the dead. Read the words of Jesus:

Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which ALL THAT ARE IN THE GRAVES shall hear His voice AND SHALL COME FORTH: they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation

John 5:28-29

The good and the evil shall all be resurrected - ALL SHALL COME FORTH. The sinner that has not been washed and cleansed by the blood of Jesus is heading for the resurrection of damnation. But

the believer that has received the blessed free gift of salvation can look forward to the resurrection of eternal life. Glory to God.

In the sermon of Jesus both the wicked rich man and righteous poor Lazarus continued to live after their physical death (Luke 16:22-23).



IN THE WORDS OF APOSTLE PAUL

But this I confess ... so worship I the God of my fathers ... And have hope toward God, ... that THERE SHALL BE A RESURRECTION OF THE DEAD, BOTH OF THE JUST AND UNJUST.

Acts 24:15

There shall be a resurrection. It is a truth of scripture. Both the just and the unjust shall be resurrected from death. There are some who say that there is no resurrection of the dead.

... How say some among you that there is no resurrection of the dead? If there is no resurrection of the dead, then is Christ not risen.

1 Corinthians 15:12-13



THERE SHALL BE TWO RESURRECTIONS

The bible speaks of two categories of resurrection. It is important that we know these truths and keep them in memory.

Brethren, I declare unto you the gospel ... which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand. By which also ye are saved, IF YE KEEP IN MEMORY

1 Corinthians 15:1-2

1. The resurrection of the righteous

It is described as follows:

- (a) The awakening to everlasting life (Daniel 12:2).
- (b) The resurrection of life (John 5:29)
- (c) The resurrection of the just (Acts 24:15)
- (d) The first resurrection (Revelation 20:4-6)

Surrender your life to Jesus Christ, and receive Him as your saviour and Lord, so you can be a part of this first resurrection.

> Blessed and holy is he that hath part in the first resurrection: on such the second death hath no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him ...

Revelation 20:6

2. The resurrection of the unrighteous

This is severally described as follows:

- (a) The awakening to shame and everlasting contempt (Daniel 12:2)
- (b) The resurrection of damnation (John 5:29)
- (c) The resurrection of the unjust (Acts 24:16)
- (d) The second resurrection (Revelation 20:5, 12-13)

Will you have your part in the first resurrection, or in the second resurrection? Those in the first resurrection are called blessed and holy. Therefore those in the second resurrection are cursed and unholy.

Repent now and surrender your heart and life to Jesus. Rededicate your heart to Jesus and turn away from the life of sin. Receive by faith the free gift of salvation through Jesus Christ.

If you know you are not born again or your heart is far from God; if you are not living right before God; if you have backslidden to sin and worldliness, PRAY THIS PRAYER WITH FAITH FOR YOUR SALVATION AND REDEDICATION.

SALVATION PRAYER

Dear Father, thank You for sending Your Son Jesus Christ to come in the flesh and die for my sins. I am sorry for any and every sin I have committed against You. I repent and ask for Your mercy, cleansing and forgiveness.

I receive and believe the price Jesus paid for me on the cross. I receive by faith the forgiveness of my sins and the free gift of salvation. I receive eternal life into my spirit now.



he word rapture is not found any where in the bible. However its relevance to the teaching of the bible is based on its meaning. Rapture means

- To be lifted in joyful ecstasy
- To be carried to another realm
- To be transported in bliss to another place or sphere.

The divine mystery of people being carried by God into His divine realm is found throughout the bible.



GOD TOOK ENOCH

And Enoch walked with God: and he was not; for God took him.

Genesis 5:24

That means, Enoch was in close, continuous intimate fellowship with God until one day he disappeared without dying, because God took him to Himself. Amplified Bible says ... God took him home with Him. NIV bible says ... God took him away.

In Hebrews 11:5, we see it very clearly Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: ...

NIV bible says

Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death; he could not be found, because God had taken him away ...

Amplified Bible version says:

Enoch was caught up and transferred to heaven ...

That is the rapture right there.

The man Enoch, being taken up to heaven by God



Elijah was also carried to heaven by God without experiencing physical death. We read in 2

Kings 2

It came to pass when the LORD would take up Elijah into heaven by a whirlwind...

Verse 1

That confirms that Elijah knew in advance that God will take him up to heaven. He also knew it will be by the means of a whirlwind.

In fact others know that Elijah was going to be taken away by God. They even knew the day it will happen. Elisha too knew it without needing to be told.

And the sons of the prophet came to Elisha and said unto him, KNOWEST THOU that the LORD will take away thy master from thy head TODAY? And he said, YEA, I KNOW IT; hold thy peace.

Verses 3 and 5

That is how real the rapture was to the people of God in the time of Elijah. Elijah knew it; Elisha knew it; and the sons of the prophet knew it too. Then the moment came:

and it came to pass, as they still went on, and talked, that, behold, THERE APPEARED A CHARIOT OF FIRE, AND HORSES OF FIRE ... and Elijah went up by a whirlwind into heaven.

Verse 11

Elijah went up, carried by God into heaven. That is how awesome and divine the rapture can be. In the case of Enoch, no one saw anything or knew when it will happen. But in the case of Elijah, it was common knowledge among spiritual people that God will take him up to heaven.



THE SAINTS SHALL BE RAPTURED

There is coming a taking away of the believers in Christ. We shall be caught up by God in the rapture.

- Angels at work

And He shall send His angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather His elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other ... Then shall two be in the field; the one shall be taken, and the other left

Matthew 24:31, 40

We shall be changed

Behold I shew you a mystery, we shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.

1 Corinthians 15:51-52

The rapture is a beautiful divine mystery. It is God's special treat for His dear saints. Brothers and sisters in Christ, prepare for that great visitation of glory. We shall all be changed.

- We shall be caught up

Beloved, the rapture is Jesus Christ the Lord, Himself, coming to receive the saints unto Himself.

For the Lord Himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord

1 Thessalonians 4:16-17

So the Lord Jesus comes with the angels, descending from heaven with a shout, trumpet blasts, and echoing archangels. It shall be a day like none other, a day the world has never seen. Picture this in your mind.

But the Lord Jesus stops in the air above the clouds. And that glorious echoing sound awakens all dead saints out of where ever they were buried. They are changed in the twinkling of an eye, and up they go in the air.



In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto

myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

John 14:2-3

Different things God created existed in their different realms and have different properties: some visible, others invisible, but all are real.



LOCATED UP ABOVE

Different references in the bible tell us the location of heaven, up, above.

Exodus 20:4 ... in heaven above

Deuteronomy ... He is God in heaven above

Psalm 103:11 ... the heaven is high above the earth

Isaiah 14:13 ... I will ascend into heaven

Luke 2:14 ... Glory to God in the highest

That means, if we had the means to keep ascending high above the earth, clouds, atmosphere, planets, galaxies, and keep on ascending far above all space – there is a place up above in the highest – called Heaven.

Hebrews 1:10 says "... the heavens are the works of thine hands". God is the one that put it up there in the highest by His hands. And when the time comes, he will cause to come down, the new Jerusalem out of heaven.

How did Jesus Christ return to heaven after His mission on earth -He ascended. He went up!

While he blessed them, he was ... carried up into heaven

Luke 24:51

Acts 1:9

When Jesus Christ return for His saints, at His second coming, how will he return – He will descend!

Then shall appear the sign of the son of man in heaven: ... they shall see the son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.

Matthew 24:30

And while they look steadfastly toward heaven as he went up ... this same Jesus, which is taken up from you into

heaven, SHALL SO COME IN LIKE MANNER as ye have seen him go into heaven

Acts 1:10-11

Child of God, heaven is a real place, up above. It was created by God, and is being prepared by Jesus for His saints. Keep that revelation in memory.

Live daily with heaven on your mind. Keep your heart pure, trusting and loving Jesus Christ with all your heart.

Heaven is real! Live daily in the consciousness and reality of heaven.

Revelation 21:23

Romans 8:18

Do not compromise or give up on your faith, purity and holiness because of pressure, persecutions, pain or problems. Live for God today, knowing you shall be clothed with His glory in heaven.

He carried me away in the spirit to a great and high mountain, and shewed me THAT GREAT CITY, THE HOLY JERUSALEM, DESCENDING OUT OF HEAVEN FROM GOD HAVING THE GLORY OF GOD ...

Revelation 21:11-12

Verses 2-3

Do not allow the problems, pressures and persecutions of this world make you give up on your walk with God. Living for God might attract

pain and persecution now, but it is never in vain. Great glory is coming.

Verily I have cleansed my heart in vain ... When I thought to know this, it was too painful for me;

Verses 14, 16

Consider the end of the wicked – eternity in the flaming fires of hell. Consider the end of the righteous – eternal glory in heaven. Living for God is never in vain. Nothing can compare to the coming glory of heaven.

Until I went into the sanctuary of God; then understood I their end ... So foolish was I, and ignorant **Verses 17,22**

Depend on the help, guidance and leading of God, so you can share in the eternal glory of heaven.

Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel and afterward receive me to glory.

Verse 24

1 Peter 1:3

The God who resurrected Jesus Christ, will also raise us from death. As the resurrection and glorification of Jesus satisfied all the pain of the cross, so will the coming glory of heaven, swallow all our pain of the past.

Every child of God should look forward in hope – a lively, living hope:

To an inheritance uncorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for us

1 Peter 1:4

Think clearly and focus your mind fully on the coming glory of heaven.

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

Colossians 3:2



HOPE IN GOD ONLY

Throughout the bible, believers are exhorted to hope in God only. Men will fail, and systems will disappoint. Only God never lies or fail.

Why art thou cast down ... hope thou in God

Psalm 42:5

of heaven.

Wait on God to the end "... for the hope which is laid up for you in heaven ..." (Colossians 1:5). Hope and wait patiently for the glory that will be given to you by God in heaven.

I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope

Psalm 130:5

But if we hope for that we see not, then do we with patience wait for it.

Romans 8:25

May you not go after the things of this world; and miss our eternal hope in Christ; the glory that shall be revealed on us in heaven.

And in this mountain shall the LORD of hosts make unto all people a feast of fat things, a feast of wines on the lees of fat things full of marrow ...

Isaiah 25:6

eaven is a place of fullness of joy, where our joy shall be made full. There shall be no sorrow or sadness in heaven. Jesus described heaven with joy.

Well done, thou good and faithful servant ... enter thou into THE JOY OF THE LORD

Matthew 25:21, 23

The return of God's children back to God is always characterised by great joy

The ransomed of the LORD shall return, and come to zion with songs

and everlasting joy ... they shall obtain gladness and joy, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away.

Isaiah 35:10

The return of a lost soul back to God in repentance, also provokes an eruption of joy in heaven.

I say unto you, that ... joy shall be in heaven over one sinner that repenteth ... there is joy in the presence of angels of God over one sinner that repenteth **Luke 15:7,10**

The joy of our return to heaven will be such this world has never seen or know. Oh my friend, do not miss eternity in heaven.

... When his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy

1 Pewter 4:13b

Exceeding joy means, joy that exceeds all that this world has ever known. Another version renders it:

"The wonderful joy of seeing His glory, when it is revealed" (NLT)

The revelation of heaven in the bible paints a picture, full of so much joy, gladness and singing.

They sung a new song saying, Thou art worthy.

Revelation 5:9

And they sung as it were a new song before the throne ...

Revelation 14:3

And they sing the song of Moses ... and the song of the Lamb, saying, Great and marvellous are thy works, Lord God Almighty

Revelation 15:3



NONE LEFT OUT

Everyone in heaven is singing and worshipping with great joy.

- The four beasts and twenty four elders (Revelation 4:8-11).

And he that sat upon the throne said, Behold I make all things new. And he said, unto me, write: for those words are true and faithful.



A HOLY CITY

And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven prepared ...

Revelation 21:2

The very name of the city shows purity and holiness. How can anything sinful, impure and defiled enter there?

And there shall in no wise enter into it

any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.
